HOMEWORK:

New homework is assigned every classday. If you do 60% of it correctly and on time, you get 10 points of 100 on the final grade.

GRADE:

There will be three quizzes and one final. The quizzes are worth 20% each and the final 30%. On a scale of 0 to 100, your final numerical grade will be given by

$$G = \frac{3 \times (2 \times \text{quiz}) + 3 \times F + \text{homework}}{10}$$

where *quiz* is the grade on the quiz, *homework* is the homework grade and *F* is final grade, and all of the grades are on a scale of 0 to 100. The final is cumulative.
